



FOREST SCHOOL

This month, year 4 children have been using Kelly Kettles for the first time.

The children were able to share how to be safe around a fire before learning specific safety rules for the Kelly Kettle.

The children worked in 3 teams. Each team resourced their fire square with safety equipment and appropriate fuel. The teams built miniature waffles and fire nests inside the kettles. Each team used a democratic method to determine who in the group would light the fire. The teams then worked together to establish the other roles.

The groups safely lit and managed their Kelly Kettle, before using the water they boiled to make hot chocolate.

The children enjoyed some free play time in the woodland before reviewing the session. The children were able to use scientific language to describe and explain the changes they observed.
