This month at Forest School the Year 5 children have been busy preparing and lighting fires in order to cook cheesy pizza wraps.

The children prepared, lit and managed their fires in small teams. They collected and sorted their own safety equipment and fuel for their fires, sharing roles and responsibilities democratically.

The children were responsible for preparing and cooking their wraps in their teams. They worked together to ensure their wraps were thoroughly cooked, and that the fire remained hot enough throughout the cooking process.

The children were able to use scientific language to describe the changes they observed in both the cheese wraps as they cooked and the fire as it burned.

The session closed with a reflection of the children's experiences and the Forest School prayer.
