



# FOREST SCHOOL

This month at Forest School, Year 3 have been learning about the importance of looking after our woodland environment.

The session started with a discussion about conservation and what we could do to protect our woodland habitat and the natural environment around us. The children then worked together in teams to each complete a different conservation project.

The projects included laying bark chip on the paths through the forest, removing the old willow dome and preparing willow to replant the willow dome.

The children used a range of tools safely, including loppers, secateurs and saws. The groups responded well to safety tool talks and demonstrated very safe independent use of these tools.

The session ended with a review of the various projects and a consideration of what else we could do at home and at school to support the environment.
