This month at Forest School, Year 4 have been learning about the importance of looking after our woodland environment. The session started with a discussion about conservation and what we could do to protect our woodland habitat and the natural environment around us.



The children then worked together in teams to each complete a different conservation project. The projects included litter picking, cutting and sorting branches for future firewood and tidying the Jubilee Garden.



The children used a range of tools safely, including loppers, secateurs and saws. The groups responded well to safety tool talks and demonstrated very safe independent use of these tools.



The session ended with a review of the various projects and a consideration of what else we could do at home and at school to support the environment.
